## SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FORM

## GENERAL RULES & ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

#### General Rules:

- 1) Scholarships are available in the amount of \$3,000.00.
- 2) Scholarships must be utilized for the scholastic year for which it was awarded.
- 3) Scholarship funds shall be given directly to the applicant 50% upon proof of enrollment for Fall semester, and then the remainder upon proof of satisfactory completion of Fall semester and proof of enrollment in Spring semester.
- 4) All scholarship awards are subject to confirmation that the recipient is in compliance with all rules, and that all eligibility requirements have been met.
- 5) Applications will be evaluated on a comparative basis at the sole discretion of the North Alamo WSC Scholarship Committee. Decisions of the Scholarship Committee will be final.
- 6) Application materials and decisions of the Scholarship Committee shall be confidential.
- 7) Acceptance of scholarship constitutes permission by North Alamo WSC to promote the name and/or likeness of scholarship winners.
- 8) North Alamo WSC reserves the right to revise or withhold the award of any or all scholarships offered at any time.
- 9) Applications must be completed in full (<u>information must be input onto the application form</u>, <u>and additional pages may be added if needed</u>) with all required supporting documentation included. Applications that are submitted incomplete will not be processed.

#### Eligibility Requirements:

- 1) Applicants and/or their dependents that have a minimum of one-year membership with NAWSC at the application deadline date are eligible to apply for this program. Proof of guardianship may be required if needed to determine membership eligibility.
- 2) Applicants must be U.S. citizens.

- 3) Scholarships are to be granted to attend an accredited program of higher learning located at a university, college, trade school, etc. anywhere in the United States, and are limited to undergraduate studies or trade school programs.
- 4) Applicant must be of good character as shown be at least three letters of recommendation from teachers, principals, counselors, mentors, etc. from the school they are currently attending. Letters must be on school letterhead and must be signed by the individual writing the letter. Electronic or typed signatures will not be accepted.
- 5) Applicant must demonstrate a willingness to pursue a course of higher learning.
- 6) Scholarships will be awarded on the basis of funds availability and the applicant's eligibility.
- 7) Applications must be received no later than 5:00 PM on February 28, 2025. The winners will be announced at our Board of Directors Meeting in May of 2025. Attendance at this meeting by all scholarship winners is mandatory.
- 8) Finalists may be called back for an interview by the scholarship committee at a date to be announced.

## Recipient Requirements / Expectations:

- 1) Recipient must maintain at least a 2.5 cumulative GPA on a 4.0 scale with their institution of higher learning and carry a minimum of 12 hours per semester or be considered by the registrar to be a full-time student.
- 2) Recipients must provide a copy of their grades and statement of account history at the end of the fall semester to North Alamo WSC before award funds can be released for the Spring semester.
- 3) Recipients must provide the university with a written release form allowing North Alamo WSC to verify grades, account history, academic standing, and enrollment status.
